Judges, comprised of industry partners, investors and entrepreneurs, will evaluate each prototype in four judging criteria, including innovation, UX/UI, functionality and technology. Prizes for the three winning teams include a cash prize of HK\$50,000, HK\$30,000 and HK\$20,000 respectively, latest technology gadgets from Microsoft and Samsung, as well as a fast-track interview opportunity for either the Cyberport Creative Micro Fund (CCMF) or the Cyberport Incubation Programme for the chance to receive seed funding. This year, additional awards such as “Best UX/UI” will be presented with the latest computer products.
